Thank you for considering the MAFN Workshop featuring Michael Wilkinson, our first in-person gathering in two years. MAFN's top priority is creating a healthy and safe environment for all participants. The COVID protocols for this event are designed for your well-being.

We continue to keep a close watch on guidance and recommendations by the World Health Organization, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the District of Columbia government, and other health authorities. We request adherence to COVID protocols for this event, as follows (subject to change):



For entry into the Cobec Building:

- Documentation of COVID Vaccination (all vaccinations and boosting) OR
- Proof of a negative COVID test taken within 72 hours of arrival on-site.
 Ideally, the test should be a Covid-19 PCR test, administered by a medical professional, presented on official paperwork. Self-administered test results will not be accepted.
- An exemption to this policy applies only to religious or medical reasons.
 When this occurs, specific health protocols must be followed, such as wearing a mask and social distancing. Otherwise, attendees will not be admitted.




Masks

- In the building: Masks required.
- In the office: Masks are encouraged, not required.



Contact Tracing

Collection of contact information is required.



COVID-19 Symptoms

- Participants are asked to stay home if they have any COVID-19 symptoms, including fever, cough, breathing, or gastrointestinal issues.
- Participants will not be admitted if they have been diagnosed with COVID-19, or any variant thereof, or have had direct contact with an individual diagnosed with or suspected to have COVID-19 in the past 14 days.
